- A. Those whose work is ***'Selected to be Exhibited at the National Students Exhibition'***.
- B. Those whose work is ***'Not Selected for Exhibition, but is Highly Commended'***.

All works submitted will be returned to each region at the beginning of September at our expense by private courier.
